Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This proposal places \$15,000,000 in the Joint Committee on Finance supplemental appropriation in order to fund grants to support hospital emergency departments. This proposal creates appropriation 20.435 (1)(bd) to allocate these funds. The bill has no fiscal effect on the Department.
