## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits the Department of Safety and Professional Services (DSPS), the Board of Nursing, the Medical Examining Board, the Occupational Therapists Affiliated Credentialing Board, the Pharmacy Examining Board, and the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling, and Social Work Examining Board from requiring an applicant to pass a statutes and rules examination as a condition of licensure or certification for all of the following professions: substance abuse counselors, clinical substance abuse counselors, and substance abuse counselors-in-training; advanced practice nurse prescribers; respiratory care practitioners; occupational therapists and occupational therapy assistants; pharmacists; professional counselors. The bill allows DSPS and the examining and credentialing boards to require an applicant for a credential to practice any of the professions listed above to affirm that the applicant has read and understands the statutes and rules that apply to the applicant's practice.

All DSPS divisions with a role in business and professional credentialing will be impacted by this bill. DSPS estimates a total of \$184,900 in one-time costs and \$49,900 in annual costs for staffing, and an indeterminate information technology cost impact to implement the bill.

The estimated one-time staffing costs of 3.5 limited term employee positions is for administrative rules coordinators and other legal staff to update rules for approximately 50 professions at 60 hours per profession. Additional costs are for staff training and updates to forms, websites, job aids and standard operating procedures. The estimated ongoing cost is for a 0.5 full time equivalent position for additional legal staff to manage an increased case load related to increased volume of complaints, investigations, and prosecutions.

The one-time and ongoing estimated costs cannot be absorbed in the currently appropriated agency budget. DSPS does not receive revenue related to administering exams for any of the professions impacted by the bill.
