Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a new tax credit program administered by WEDC. The program would allow sole proprietors of a business to claim a tax credit for up to three years after hiring their first full-time employee. The tax credit amount would taper down in each successive year.

WEDC assumes additional full-time staff will be necessary to satisfy the administration and verification of requirements outlined in the bill.

The corporation assumes new data-sharing MOUs with other state agencies will be needed to administer the program as drafted under the proposal.

The corporation assumes new business information and technology systems will be necessary to administer the program as drafted under the proposal.

No additional funding is made available through this proposal, thus adding these requirements to the corporation will reduce resources available for other activities and programs.
