<b>Description</b> calculating a consolidated school district's revenue limit					

### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, if two or more districts are consolidated, and one or more of those districts has approved additional revenue authority above the normal revenue limit via an operating referendum, for school years beginning on or after the effective date of the consolidation, the approval for those school years automatically expires on the effective date of the consolidation.

This bill repeals that provision in state law. Therefore, under the bill, a newly consolidated school district would retain the additional revenue authority gained via referenda from the consolidating school districts (according to the specifications of the approved referenda).

Local Impact: Indeterminate

DPI is unable to predict the number of districts that will enter into consolidation agreements and utilize the provisions under this bill. However, consolidating districts would be able to maintain the additional revenue authority, allowing for increased expenditures. The amount of additional revenue authority would vary by district depending on the referendum passed.

State Impact: None

This bill would have no state fiscal impact.
