Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

I. Bill Summary

The bill includes several provisions regarding wetland boundary delineation:

- 1. It adds a wetland assured delineation program as a fourth method to delineate the boundaries of a wetland in a manner recognized by DNR.
- 2. It requires DNR to charge a \$500 application processing fee to assured delineator applicants.
- 3. It requires DNR to charge a \$1,200 annual certification fee to an assured delineator.
- 4. It requires a report of each wetland delineation an assured delineator prepares, and allows the DNR to charge a filing fee not to exceed \$20 for each report submitted.
- 5. It provides that a wetland delineation prepared by an assured delineator is effective for five years from the date upon which the wetland delineation report is submitted to DNR.
- 5. It requires DNR to review the performance of assured delineators on a recurring basis and authorizes DNR to perform in-field audits of specific wetland delineations.
- 6. It requires the DNR to consider a person who is approved or certified as an assured delineator under an existing pilot program as certified as an assured delineator under the program created in the bill.

II. Assumptions

Under the existing pilot program:

- 1. There are currently 45 assured delineators. This estimate assumes a relatively stable number of participants in the assured delineator program into the future.
- 2. On average, approximately 10 people apply to gain assured status per year. This estimate assumes that amount will remain relatively stable into the future.
- 3. There are approximately 700 assured wetland delineations submitted per year. This estimate assumes that amount will remain relatively stable in the future.
- III. State Fiscal Effect

1. Costs

One-time and ongoing costs to implement the bill are estimated to be minimal since the bill codifies the pilot program delineation practices and procedures.

2. Revenues

- a. Certification Fee: the bill would increase the annual certification fee by \$300, from \$900 to \$1200. Assuming 45 assured delineators per year, the bill would increase annual program revenue by $$13,500 (45 \times $300)$.
- b. Application Processing Fee: the bill would require the Department to charge a \$500 application processing fee to assured delineator applicants. Assuming 10 applicants per year, the bill would increase annual program revenue by $$5,000 (10 \times $500)$.

c. Report Filing Fee: the bill allows the Department to charge a \$20 filing fee for each wetland delineation report submitted. Assuming that the Department opts to charge the fee, and assuming that there are 700 reports submitted per year, the bill would increase annual program revenue by \$14,000 (700 x \$20). d. In total, the bill is estimated to increase annual program revenue by \$32,500.
