Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2023 AB 303 makes several changes to the broadband expansion grant program, which is administered by the Public Service Commission (Commission). The bill eliminates the term "underserved", which is currently defined as an area served by less than two broadband providers, from statutes. 2023 AB 303 amends the definition of "unserved" to no provider offering service of 100 Mbps download and 20 Mbps upload. The service must be available and reliable. 2023 AB 303 gives the Commission the ability every two years, via the rulemaking process, to adjust the speed thresholds in the unserved definition to align with changes in technology and actual market conditions.

2023 AB 303 requires grant program applicants to participate in the FCC's Affordable Connectivity Program or any federally mandated successor program. The bill also modifies the statutory priority factors related to matching funds and geographic area and adds a priority factor for projects that meet certain speed thresholds. In addition, the bill expands the list of items that the Commission shall consider when evaluating applications to include whether an applicant offers a low-cost broadband service option to be eligible for funding under the federal Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment program or participates in the FCC's Affordable Connectivity Program or any federally mandated successor program.

2023 AB 303 creates statutory provisions outlining a challenge process for grant applications. The provision requires the Commission to publish the proposed geographic broadband service area and speeds for each application submitted within ten days of the close of the application period. Internet service providers (ISP) in or proximate to a proposed project area may, within 30 days of the publication of this information, challenge an application by demonstrating that the ISP currently provides available and reliable fixed wireless or wired broadband service with speeds of 100 Mbps download and 20 Mbps upload. The ISP may also challenge on the grounds that they commit to complete construction to provide available and reliable fixed wireless or wired broadband service with speeds of 100 Mbps download and 20 Mbps upload within 24 months after the grants are made. If the Commission determines that the challenge is credible, the Commission is prohibited from funding the successfully challenged locations. If the ISP does not fulfill its commitment to provide broadband service within 24 months after the grants are made, the bill prohibits the Commission from awarding grants to the ISP for the following two grant cycles and the ISP is prohibited from participating in the challenge process for the following two grant cycles. The Commission will need 1.0 FTE to manage this challenge process. The annual salary, fringe and associated supplies and services costs for this position is \$111,200.
