Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Assembly Bill 323 (AB 323) ratifies the contract negotiated between the State of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Attorneys Association. The statewide fiscal impact pertains to the wage increases in the fiscal year (FY) 2022-23 agreement for employees in the professional legal collective bargaining unit. The total count of state employees in the professional legal collective bargaining unit for the FY 2022-23 agreement is 254.30 FTE. The statewide base payroll is \$25,299,095, which is consistent with s. 111.91 (3) (b), Wis. Stats., based on the bargaining unit snapshot of January 2, 2022, for the pay period ending 180 days prior to the end of the previous contract period.

Each employee in the classification of Attorney in the professional legal bargaining unit will receive a General Wage Adjustment (GWA) of 4.7%, with back pay to January 1, 2023, and with certain lump sum payment provisions applied instead if the position's salary is in excess of the maximum of the classification's pay range.

The increased total cost resulting from the pertaining GWA is equal to \$450,640 (consisting of \$108,379 GPR and \$342,261 for all other fund sources), including salary and fringe benefits at the variable fringe rate.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

All costs contained herein are through the end of FY 2022-23, and do not include the cost to continue in FY 2023-24, which when inclusive of the 27 pay periods is equal to \$1,009,572.
