## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill makes changes to the low-income housing credit by expanding the annual limit WHEDA may certify credits under the program to \$100 million from \$42 million and allows those credits to be carried back to the previous tax year to offset net tax. The bill also instructs WHEDA to ensure that at least 35% of certified credits are for housing projects in rural areas. Additionally, the bill allows insurance companies to use the credit to offset insurance premium fees.

#### Fiscal Estimate

The fiscal impact of the bill is unknown, but could be as high as \$58 million annually if all credits are certified and claimed. To the extent that WHEDA allocated fewer credits, the fiscal impact will be commensurately lower. Moreover, because the credit can be used to offset insurance premium fees, the fiscal effect may be a mix between reductions in those fees and reductions to corporate and franchise taxes.

Because this bill reduces tax revenue, it may impact the state's maintenance of effort requirement under the American Rescue Plan Act. The Dept of Administration should review this bill for this specific purpose to provide further clarity on the matter.
