Description required human trafficking prevention instruction in certain grades and teacher training related to identifying victims of child trafficking		

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would require DCF to assist DPI in creating a curriculum for teaching children in grades 7 to 12 about human trafficking prevention. While this would create additional time requirements, the fiscal effect is likely negligible and could be absorbed within the existing agency budget.

This act creates no new revenue sources and does not increase chapter 20 authority.

There will likely be an increase in costs for school districts as schools will need to add the new curriculum. In addition, faculty must receive training in identifying victims of sex trafficking.
