## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires the Department of Financial Institutions (DFI) to establish and manage a retirement plan marketplace for the purpose of connecting Wisconsin residents and employers with fewer than 100 employees, in which at least one employee is a Wisconsin resident, with retirement plans offered by private financial services firms.

Under the bill, DFI is required to develop a marketing plan for the retirement plan marketplace and cooperate with other state agencies, including the Department of Workforce Development (DWD), in providing marketing and outreach services to employers and individuals. Agency responsibilities and duties regarding cooperation with DFI are not defined in the bill.

DWD assumes that this bill will have no fiscal impact.

Duties related to agency cooperation are not specified and DWD assumes that staff time and costs related to cooperating with DFI would be covered under normal operations.
