Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2023 SB 455 subjects municipal storm water utilities to the full authority of the Public Service Commission (Commission) to regulate rates and services. Under current law the more than 120 Wisconsin municipal storm water utilities are generally not subject to the Commission's jurisdiction. The Commission does, however, address complaints by users that municipal storm water utility rates, rules, or practices are unreasonable or unjustly discriminatory.

2023 SB 455 has a significant impact on both storm water utilities and the Commission. Commission staff would need to establish and review accounting standards and rate methodologies, conduct audits, develop reasonable rates and tariffs, review construction projects, and respond to utility requests to update tariffs. Additionally, Commission staff would have to develop application materials, update data collection and annual report systems and develop other key processes to ensure statutory compliance. Municipal storm water utilities are not currently subject to these requirements and would need to implement processes to respond to the requirements in all these areas. The Commission would provide technical assistance and outreach to support the implementation.

The Commission will need 5.5 FTE to accomplish the regulatory activities included in 2023 SB 455. The annual costs are as followed:

Salary: \$454,800
Fringe Benefits: \$158,500
Supplies and Services: \$55,000
Total: \$668,300

As a program revenue agency, the Commission would recover these costs via utility assessments. 2023 SB 455 would generate \$668,300 in program revenues as well as \$74,300 in revenue for state operations (GPR Earned), as required under Wis. Stat. 196.85.
