Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

According to LRB, under current law, a school must provide each teacher a daily duty-free 30-minute lunch period, or the school board may enter into a contract with a teacher for services during the teacher's lunch period.

This bill prohibits a school board from requiring its teachers to perform any services outside of regular classroom instruction unless the school board compensates the teacher for his or her time.

Local Impact: Indeterminate

DPI does not collect data on how many hours teachers work that are outside of regular classroom instruction and not compensated. The total amount that schools would be required to absorb for additional costs associated with additional hours outside of classroom time worked by teachers is therefore indeterminate.
