Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill permits individuals over the age of 18 who are terminally ill, and meet certain conditions, to request medication for the purpose of ending their lives. This proposal requires the Department to develop and distribute forms to be used for reporting by attending providers in the context of request for medication. Department responsibilities will include basic tasks, such as responding to inquiries, and updating information materials. It is assumed that these activities will be able to be completed by existing Department staff.
