Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

As proposed, this bill eliminates prohibitions on the use of eminent domain to establish or extend recreational trails, bicycle ways and lanes, or pedestrian ways. It is anticipated this elimination would provide more flexibility and decreased costs when completing projects that require the acquisition of land for the prohibited purposes. However, the actual fiscal impact is indeterminant because it is dependent on the types of projects undertaken and the negotiations on the land's purchase price.
