Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill allows an individual who possesses a credential as a health care provider in another state to provide health care services by telehealth in this state within the scope of practice established under the laws and rules of this state by registering with the Department of Safety and Professional Services (DSPS) or an applicable credentialing board. It requires DSPS and any applicable credentialing board to register an out-of-state health care provider who does not possess a credential in this state as a telehealth provider who may provide health care services in this state by telehealth if the health care provider meets certain criteria outlined in the bill. The bill allows DSPS and applicable credentialing boards to take disciplinary action against a health care provider registered to provide telehealth services under certain specified circumstances. Finally, the bill requires DSPS to publish on its website a list of all health care providers registered to provide telehealth services under the bill and include, to the extent applicable, certain information specified in the bill.

DSPS estimates a total of \$75,200 in one-time costs and \$304,000 in ongoing costs for staffing and indeterminate but potentially significant additional IT costs to implement the provisions in this bill. The estimated one-time staffing need is for 1.5 limited term employee (LTE) for rulemaking, staff training, template modification, software updates, and website and forms updates. The estimated annual staffing need for is for 3.3 full time equivalent (FTE) legal and related support staff for processing 150 complaints per year and opening 75 investigations associated with these complaints, prosecution of cases, records requests, responding to inquiries, and reviewing applications. The one-time and annual estimated costs cannot be absorbed in the currently appropriated agency budget.
