Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates an exception to the prohibition on a person carrying a firearm in certain places for a tactical emergency medical services (TEMS) professional who is certified by the Law Enforcement Standards Board (LESB). This exception mirrors that currently provided for law enforcement officers acting in the line of duty. The bill requires the (LESB) to establish minimum training standards to certify the TEMS professionals.

The Bureau of Training and Standards within DOJ would work with LESB in establishing the training standards under the bill. The Department believes that this work could be completed with existing staff and therefore any costs could be absorbed.
