Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a legislative joint committee on state mandates and requires the committee to review all new legislation that places a requirement on local governments that has uncompensated fiscal effects. This bill would prohibit legislation referred to the committee from further consideration without a report from the committee or 30 days. If a bill under review by the committee is determined to have an uncompensated fiscal effect, the committee shall offer an amendment to fund the mandate. This bill also prohibits state agencies from promulgating rules that impose a mandate on local governments or take an action required by law that establishes a mandate unless the rule or action is establishing the mandate is funded.

This bill may create additional work for staff at the Department of Children and Families (DCF) however it is anticipated that this work can be absorbed without additional funding. The Department is not certain how to define minimal fiscal impact as it relates to existing funding provided by DCF to local governments for activities specified in law or rule and thus the fiscal effect of this bill on local governments is indeterminate.
