Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The WEC could not identify any mechanism by which the bill would significantly impact local government costs. It is possible that increased access to in person absentee voting would increase demand for the service, and thus result in somewhat higher labor costs for some towns, villages, and cities. It appears equally possible that overall demand would not change, and the bill would simply permit the workload to be distributed over a larger time period. The ultimate impact depends upon voter behavior, which is difficult to forecast.
