Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would create a council on human trafficking which would include, among other members, the Secretary of DCF or a designee thereof. DCF would also be required to work with the council on the regulation and oversight of congregate care facilities in relation to victims of sex trafficking. While this would create additional time requirements, the fiscal effect is likely negligible and could be absorbed within the existing agency budget.

This act creates no new revenue sources and does not increase chapter 20 authority.

There will likely be an increase in costs for counties as they are required to participate in the council and may potentially be part of a task force for their county. Since the nature of the activities is uncertain and the number of counties involved is uncertain, the cost is indeterminate.
