Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill expands the Silver Alert system administered by the Department of Justice (DOJ) to include specific situations not currently covered by the Amber Alert system. Specifically, under the bill, a Silver Alert could be issued for a missing person under 18 to whom an Amber Alert does not apply if the person is believed to be incapable of returning home without assistance due to a physical or mental condition or disability or if the person is under 10.

DOJ currently has 2.0 FTE managing the Silver Alert System. It is estimated that adding the additional categories of individuals to the system will approximately double the number of alerts issued. Based on current costs of the existing staff, the Department would require 2.0 additional FTE Program and Planning Analyst at an annualized cost of \$236,700.

Local law enforcement agencies may incur additional costs as they coordinate with the state staff on the alerts. The cost of this increased coordination cannot be determined.
