**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 450**

October 7, 2025 - Offered by Representative HAYWOOD.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** funding for the department of safety and professional
2 services and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1. Fiscal changes.**

4 (1) SUPPLIES AND SERVICES FUNDING. In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for
5 the appropriation to the department of safety and professional services under s.
6 20.165 (1) (g), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2025-26 is increased by \$209,000 to
7 provide funding for ongoing supplies and services. In the schedule under s. 20.005
8 (3) for the appropriation to the department of safety and professional services under
9 s. 20.165 (1) (g), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2026-27 is increased by \$209,000
10 to provide funding for ongoing supplies and services.

1 (2) DATA-DRIVEN DECISION-MAKING POSITION. (a) In the schedule under s.
2 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the department of safety and professional
3 services under s. 20.165 (1) (g), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2025-26 is
4 increased by \$48,640 to provide funding for 0.8 PR senior research analyst position.
5 In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the department of safety
6 and professional services under s. 20.165 (1) (g), the dollar amount for fiscal year
7 2026-27 is increased by \$61,680 to provide ongoing funding for the position
8 authorized under this subsection.

9 (b) In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the department
10 of safety and professional services under s. 20.165 (2) (j), the dollar amount for
11 fiscal year 2025-26 is increased by \$12,160 to provide funding for 0.2 PR senior
12 research analyst position. In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the appropriation
13 to the department of safety and professional services under s. 20.165 (2) (j), the
14 dollar amount for fiscal year 2026-27 is increased by \$15,420 to provide ongoing
15 funding for the position authorized under this subsection.

16 (3) CALL CENTER POSITIONS. In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the
17 appropriation to the department of safety and professional services under s. 20.165
18 (1) (g), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2025-26 is increased by \$956,400 to provide
19 funding for 14.0 PR customer service call center office operations associate
20 positions. In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the
21 department of safety and professional services under s. 20.165 (1) (g), the dollar
22 amount for fiscal year 2026-27 is increased by \$1,083,200 to provide ongoing
23 funding for the positions authorized under this subsection.

24 (4) ADMINISTRATIVE RULES OFFICER POSITION. In the schedule under s. 20.005

1 (3) for the appropriation to the department of safety and professional services under
2 s. 20.165 (1) (g), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2025-26 is increased by \$75,100 to
3 provide funding for 1.0 PR administrative rules officer position. In the schedule
4 under s. 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the department of safety and
5 professional services under s. 20.165 (1) (g), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2026-
6 27 is increased by \$96,100 to provide ongoing funding for the position authorized
7 under this subsection.

8 (5) LEGAL SUPPORT STAFF. In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the
9 appropriation to the department of safety and professional services under s. 20.165
10 (1) (g), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2025-26 is increased by \$271,800 to provide
11 funding for 3.0 PR paralegal positions and 1.0 PR attorney position to conduct
12 casework for the investigation and discipline of credential holders. In the schedule
13 under s. 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the department of safety and
14 professional services under s. 20.165 (1) (g), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2026-
15 27 is increased by \$358,300 to provide ongoing funding for the positions authorized
16 under this subsection.

17 (6) LICENSE PROCESSING STAFF. In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the
18 appropriation to the department of safety and professional services under s. 20.165
19 (1) (g), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2025-26 is increased by \$875,500 to provide
20 funding for 1.0 PR paralegal positions and 9.0 PR license permit program associate
21 positions to conduct credential application processing. In the schedule under s.
22 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the department of safety and professional
23 services under s. 20.165 (1) (g), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2026-27 is

1 increased by \$875,500 to provide ongoing funding for the positions authorized
2 under this subsection.
