**SENATE AMENDMENT 2,
TO SENATE BILL 15**

November 14, 2025 - Offered by Senator JACQUE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 5, line 3: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
3 with line 7 and substitute:

4 “**SECTION 12g.** 939.623 (3) of the statutes is renumbered 939.623 (3) (a) and
5 amended to read:

6 939.623 (3) (a) This section applies to a crime involving an elder person crime
7 victim irrespective of whether the defendant had actual knowledge of the crime
8 victim’s age. A mistake regarding the crime victim’s age is not a defense to an
9 increased penalty under this section.

10 **SECTION 12r.** 939.623 (3) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

11 939.623 (3) (b) This section applies to a crime involving an adult at risk crime

1 victim only if the defendant had actual knowledge that the crime victim is an adult
2 at risk.”.

3 **2.** Page 6, line 21: delete the material beginning with “irrespective of
4 whether” and ending with “paragraph” on page 7, line 2, and substitute “only if the
5 defendant had actual knowledge that the victim is an adult at risk”.

6 **3.** Page 7, line 2: delete SECTION 24m and substitute:

7 “**SECTION 24q.** 940.66 (4) (title) of the statutes, as affected by 2025 Wisconsin
8 Act 24, is amended to read:

9 940.66 (4) (title) ~~KNOWLEDGE OF AGE NOT REQUIRED.~~

10 **SECTION 24r.** 940.66 (4) of the statutes, as affected by 2025 Wisconsin Act 24,
11 is renumbered 940.66 (4) (a) and amended to read:

12 940.66 (4) (a) This section applies to a crime involving an elder person victim
13 irrespective of whether the defendant had actual knowledge of the victim’s age. A
14 mistake regarding the victim’s age is not a defense to a prosecution under this
15 section.

16 **SECTION 24s.** 940.66 (4) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

17 940.66 (4) (b) This section applies to a crime involving an adult at risk victim
18 only if the defendant had actual knowledge that the victim is an adult at risk.”.
