Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill provides the state with concurrent jurisdiction over matters involving juveniles on land ceded by Wisconsin to the United States government for federal use. The bill would require the governor to accept retrocession of jurisdiction for any juvenile who is 10 years old or older who is alleged to be delinquent, if offered by an appropriate federal authority.

DHS provides treatment services to juveniles at the Mendota Juvenile Treatment Center. The Department estimates that the bill's provisions would not have a measurable impact on the census at the Center and therefore would not increase costs to the Department.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
