## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The bill establishes a statutory right to abortion access and repeals numerous existing abortion restrictions.

The Department of Employee Trust Funds (ETF) administers the State Group Health Insurance Program (GHIP) for state employees and participating local governmental employees through the Group Insurance Board (GIB). The following provisions in the bill affect the GHIP.

- Requires that each health care coverage plan offered by the GIB that includes maternity coverage must also provide coverage for abortion and any medically necessary services related to abortion.
- Repeals current statutory provisions that prohibit the GIB from offering abortion coverage.

The department will incur administrative costs related to updating health plan vendor contracts and the revision of multiple publications. The department should be able to absorb these costs.

Abortion services can have a wide range of costs depending on the circumstances. Due to the variable costs with the coverage outlined in the bill, the fiscal impact on the GHIP is indeterminate.
