Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill eliminates the annuity suspension requirement for law enforcement officer and firefighter participants who return to work for an employer who participates in the WRS and who works more than two-thirds of full time.

Administrative costs for the Department of Employee Trust Funds will be incurred related to information technology system changes, staff training, employer training, transaction processing and the revision of multiple publications. The department should be able to absorb these costs.

The Department is not able to determine the fiscal impact of the bill on local governments.

The estimate does not include WRS program related costs. Joint Survey Committee on Retirement Systems provides the estimate of WRS program related costs.
