Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill creates a dairy cattle innovation program, under which the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC) provides no-interest loans to eligible milk producers for certain activities. According to the proposal, WEDC may consult with the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) to administer this program. There is no funding appropriated to operate the program in the bill.

Since WEDC is the principal entity expected to administer the program with the prerogative to consult with DATCP as needed, DATCP does not expect to be fiscally impacted by the proposed bill.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

There is currently no long-range fiscal implication for this bill. However, depending on the degree to which DATCP is consulted by WEDC in administering this program and the related resource needs, DATCP's assessment of the fiscal implications might warrant a revision in the future.
