Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires the DPI to administer a pilot program with an entity, to provide a virtual reality technology program. The program would be piloted in one rural school district, one suburban school district, and one urban school district, which would be selected by DPI.

The program must be:

Aligned with state model standards for math and science in grades 6 to 12

Demonstrate significant improvements

Include a formative assessment platform

The entity must provide the virtual reality technology program to at least 16,000 pupils and provide at least 3,200 virtual reality headsets.

The DPI is required to provide coaching to individuals who will be participating in the program. DPI must ensure that the program is effectively administered in the classroom.

State impact: Indeterminate

The cost of implementing the proposed program is indeterminate. DPI does not currently have the infrastructure to administer the proposed new virtual reality grant program - to administer the grant, or to provide training & technical assistance (coaching), or evaluation of the program's efficacy.

The bill provides no funding, either for the grants or for agency operations to conduct the require work. The cost of 1.0 FTE employee to do this work would depend on the position classification, but assuming a competitive salary to attract qualified candidates, the cost for a position could be approximately \$110,000 (direct salary and benefits, as well as fixed [overhead] and IT support costs, necessary travel, etc.) DPI does not have information to provide a reasonably accurate estimate for the amount necessary for school districts to purchase curriculum and equipment for a virtual reality technology program as described in the bill.
