## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB-0132/SB-0124 directs the WEDC to organize the creation of a "Nuclear Power Summit Board" for the state of Wisconsin. The Nuclear Power Summit Board would be made up of six voting members and at least 3 nonvoting members who would elect a chairperson as the sole officer for the Board. The Board is expected to meet at least once in CY2025 and at least three times per calendar year until July 1, 2030. The Board with the assistance of the WEDC is expected to organize a "Wisconsin Nuclear Power Summit" in Madison, WI a month after instruction begins at UW-Madison's new College of Engineering building to promote Wisconsin's achievements in the field of nuclear power and fusion energy. This event can be funded by registration fees for Summit participants.

The proposal describes creating a new appropriation for the WEDC to fund this, but if no appropriation is made this bill will not be in effect.

In order to administer this proposal, the Corporation estimates that the event cost would be \$250,000 based upon the prior cost of similar WEDC events. This amount would cover the additional costs and resources required of the WEDC to administer the meetings/activities of the Nuclear Summit Board.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
