## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill requires a political subdivision to reduce the fee it charges for a building permit by 75 percent or \$500, whichever reduction is less, if the permit is for improvements to the primary residence of a disabled veteran, the improvements are necessary to accommodate a disability of the disabled veteran, and the residence is owned by the disabled veteran or a caretaker of the disabled veteran.

The fiscal estimate is indeterminate as the department does not have detailed data on building permit fees. In 2023, local governments had total building and inspection fee revenues of \$104.79 million.

The bill has no state fiscal effect.
