#### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill requires the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to waive annual state parks and forests vehicle admission fees for parents or guardians of children who provide proof of enrollment in the National Parks "Every Kid Outdoors" program for 4th graders.

#### I. Assumptions

- A. In calendar year 2023, annual vehicle admission revenue for the Wisconsin State Park System (WSPS) totaled \$16,872,913. Removing non-resident and WI resident senior sales revenue reduces that total \$10,470,416.
- B. According to the U.S. Census Bureau, there were an estimated 2,446,028 households in Wisconsin in July 2024.
- C. According to the Department of Public Instruction 2023-2024 school year enrollment report, there were approximately 65,911 4th grade students enrolled in public and private schools in Wisconsin;
- D. Based on the aforementioned assumptions, the department assumes 2.69% of Wisconsin households have a 4th grade student (65,911 / 2,446,028 = 0.0269).
- II. State Fiscal Impact Revenue
- A. If 100% of 4th grade households access the waiver and visit department properties requiring a vehicle admission fee, the bill would reduce annual WSPS fee revenue by \$281,654 (\$10,470,416 x .0269), subject to change due to future vehicle admission fee increases and future demographic changes.
- B. If one-third of 4th grade households access the waiver and visit department properties requiring a vehicle admission fee, the bill would reduce annual WSPS fee revenue by \$92,945 (\$10,470,416 x .0269 x 0.33), subject to change due to future vehicle admission fee increases and future demographic changes.
- C. Given those two scenarios, the bill could reduce annual WSPS admission fee revenue between \$93,000 \$281,700.
- D. The department characterizes the overall revenue impact of the bill to be indeterminate since it is difficult to accurately estimate the percentage of 4th grade households that would opt to take advantage of the waiver.
- III. State Fiscal Impact Costs

#### A. One-Time Costs

WSPS will need to develop and implement procedures for tracking fee waiver requests at estimated one-time cost of \$3,000.

#### B. Ongoing Costs

WSPS estimates that 500 hours/year of Limited Term Employee (LTE) staff time would be needed to process requests, track total fees waived, and analyze and maintain data. Annual costs for that staff time are estimated to be \$13,200 [(\$21/hr. + 25.37% agency-wide LTE fringe rate) x 500 hours].
