Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The Department of Workforce Development (DWD) related provisions of this bill requires the Higher Education Aids Board (HEAB), in cooperation with DWD, to prepare a list of Wisconsin's 50 most in-demand jobs. The proposed list includes information on each job's average starting salary and required education level. These provisions are estimated to have no material fiscal impact on DWD or local governments. The department gathers this information as a part of the agency's standard operations. DWD regularly collects labor market data on job growth, job openings, and those positions' required education level and average salaries.
