## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires higher education institutions to report cost and student outcome data to high school junior and seniors relating to their undergraduate degree programs to the Higher Educational Aids Board (HEAB). In turn, HEAB must annually provide this information to the Department of Public Instruction with a list, prepared in cooperation with the Department of Workforce Development, of the 50 most in-demand jobs in this state, including starting salary and required education level for each job.

Some of the information required in this bill is already collected by the UW and is publicly available.

## **Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

The fiscal impact of reporting to HEAB and collecting data not currently available is unclear until guidelines are established for the provisions of the bill.
