### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits persons from entering or remaining at a campground without the consent of the campground's operator. The bill further requires a law enforcement officer to take enforcement actions, including arrest, when a person is deemed to be trespassing on a campground.

The matter of criminal trespass at a campground and execution of penalty is outside the regulatory duties and enforcement powers of the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP). DATCP, therefore, expects no attributable cost to the department with respect to this bill.

### Long-Range Fiscal Implications

This bill is not expected to have long-range fiscal implications for DATCP.
