## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, a person who wishes to practice professional nursing must be licensed by the Board of Nursing as a registered nurse (RN). This bill creates an additional system of licensure for advanced practice registered nurses (APRNs) along with the ability for APRNs to practice independently if they meet certain educational requirements. There would be no fiscal impact on the Department, as work related to this legislation would require minimal updates to policy and procedure language in related programs. This work can absorbed by existing Department staff.
