Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2025 Senate Bill 27 would require all employees of the Legislature to perform their work in-person at their respective physical office locations. The Legislature, including both chambers as well as the six legislative service agencies, has not allocated funding for remote work. In addition, the aforementioned units of the Legislature have sufficient space for employees to perform duties in-person. The bill also does not contain any appropriations. Therefore, the bill would have no fiscal effect for the Legislature.
