Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits the use of state, local, or certain federal funds to subsidize, reimburse, or otherwise provide compensation for any health care services provided to individuals who are not lawfully present in the United States.

Should this legislation be enacted, the Department has 8th Amendment concerns about not providing healthcare. The 1976 Supreme Court case Estelle v. Gamble, established the deliberate failure to address medical needs of an inmate constitutes cruel and unusual punishment.

In Fiscal Year 24, the Department's cost of providing healthcare was \$7,700/person. This amount excludes salary and fringe benefit costs of healthcare personnel.

The fiscal impact of this bill is indeterminate.
