## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Statutory responsibility for ballot printing in Wisconsin rests with the counties. Counties may experience a small decrease in supply and postage costs, because current primary ballots are often lengthy and require the use of more costly 17 inch ballot stock. The bill might enable simpler ballot forms and thus the use of smaller and less expensive ballot stock. Actual savings may be negligible but higher costs are not anticipated.
