Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits the state from sharing data with the federal government that contains personally identifiable information if the data is not first masked or otherwise anonymized and authorizing a civil cause of action for negligent violations of that prohibition. The bill does provide exceptions for a state agency to share unmasked data with federal officials to the extent necessary to comply with other state or federal laws, or to carry out the administration of a state or federal program.

The fiscal effect of this bill is unable to be determined without researching each program to determine what personally identifiable information is shared, whether it is anonymized and whether it is a program requirement or law. If the agency does share personally identifiable information with the federal government that is not required in law or program, the cost to anonymize the data would impact the agency.
