Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill pertains to political subdivisions, counties and municipalities, and their ability to pass ordinances pertaining to the impounding of vehicles. The Wisconsin State patrol does not enforce ordinance violations, only applicable state laws and adopted federal regulations. This bill will have no annual fiscal effect on the Department of Transportation. It will create no new annual expenditures or revenues.

The Department of Transportation does not know which political subdivisions have impound ordinances or which political subdivisions are likely to implement new impounding ordinances. The Department of Transportation also does not have enough information about the costs associated with impounding vehicles for individual local law enforcement agencies.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

This bill will have no annual fiscal effect on the Department of Transportation. It will create no new annual expenditures or revenues.
