REFERENCE BUREAU CORRECTIONS

Assembly Amendment 2 to **Assembly Bill 241**

1. Page 1, line 2: delete lines 2 to 6.
****NOTE: These lines are moved to item 6 of the bill so that the statutes treated appear in numerical order. See item 3.
2. Page 1, line 7: delete lines 7 and 8 and substitute:
"2m. Page 1, line 3: delete that line and substitute:
"**SECTION 1b.** 106.015 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 106.015 (1m) and amended to read:".".
****NOTE: This item fixes a punctuation issue.
3. Page 2, line 4: before that line insert:
"**SECTION 1e.** 106.015 (1g) of the statutes is created to read: 106.015 (1g) In this section, "construction trade" means a trade, craft, or business that the department has, for purposes of its approval of apprenticeship programs under this chapter,

identified as being a construction trade.".
****NOTE: These lines appeared in material deleted by item 1. This CCC adds no new text.

4. Page 2, line 4: delete ""**SECTION 1g**" and substitute "**SECTION 1g**".
5. Page 2, line 12: delete "~~sub. subs.~~ (1) ~~does~~" and substitute "~~sub. (1) does~~ subs. (1m)."
