COMMUNICATIONS

The Chief Clerk received the following coauthor and cosponsor requests on June 17, 2025:

Senator Habush Sinykin added as a cosponsor of **Assembly Bill 176**, relating to: financial eligibility for the Alzheimer's family and caregiver support program.

Representative O'Connor added as a coauthor of **Assembly Bill 198**, relating to: emergency medical services education, tuition and materials reimbursement for emergency medical responders and emergency medical services practitioners, and a live 911 pilot program.

Representative Prado added as a coauthor of **Assembly Bill 201**, relating to: extortion, sexual extortion, and providing a penalty.

Representative O'Connor added as a coauthor of **Assembly Bill 232**, relating to: transferring adjudicatory functions for worker's compensation from the Division of Hearings and Appeals in the Department of Administration to the Department of Workforce Development.

Representative O'Connor added as a coauthor of **Assembly Bill 234**, relating to: the electronic vaping device directory and electronic nicotine devices.

Representative O'Connor added as a coauthor of **Assembly Bill 242**, relating to: tampering with telecommunication or electric wires and providing a penalty.

Representative O'Connor added as a coauthor of **Assembly Bill 269**, relating to: delivery network couriers and transportation network drivers, Department of Financial Institutions' approval to offer portable benefit accounts, providing for insurance coverage, modifying administrative rules related to accident and sickness insurance, and granting rule-making authority.

Representative VanderMeer added as a coauthor of **Assembly Joint Resolution 50**, Relating to: recognizing the United States Army's 250th birthday.
