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2025 Wisconsin Act 5 [2025 Senate Bill 68] Prescription Drug Monitoring Program

2025 WISCONSIN ACT 5

Under current law, the Controlled Substances Board must establish a Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) that requires a pharmacy or health care practitioner to generate a record to document the dispensing of certain monitored prescription drugs.

2025 Wisconsin Act 5 extends the expiration of the requirement that a practitioner or a practitioner's agent review a patient's records under the PDMP before a practitioner issues a prescription order for the patient from April 1, 2025 to April 1, 2030.

The act also extends the expiration of the requirement that the board conduct a quarterly review of the PDMP to evaluate the actual outcomes of the PDMP compared with projected outcomes from October 30, 2025 to October 30, 2030. Additionally, the act extends the expiration of the requirement that the board report the results of the review quarterly to the Department of Safety and Professional Services from October 30, 2025 to October 30, 2030.
