2025 Wisconsin Act 18
[2025 Senate Bill 31]

Physician Assistant and Advanced Practice Nurse State Agency Status

BACKGROUND

Prior law provided that a physician who is not employed by a local health department but who provides services without compensation for the programs and services provided by a local health department that require medical oversight is, for the provision of those services, a state agent of the Department of Health Services (DHS) for certain legal purposes and liability protections.

Prior law also provided that a physician who is not employed by a school district or local health department, but who supervises a school district or a local health department immunization program or issues immunization orders in accordance with DHS written protocols for the school district or local health department, is considered a state agent of DHS for certain legal purposes and liability protections.

2025 WISCONSIN ACT 18

2025 Wisconsin Act 18 provides that, in addition to a physician, a physician assistant or advanced practice nurse prescriber may provide services that require medical oversight for a local health department and supervise a local immunization program with state agency status.
