2025 Wisconsin Act 73 [2025 Assembly Bill 273]

Membership of the Controlled Substances Board

State law assigns certain responsibilities to the Controlled Substances Board with respect to the scheduling and regulation of controlled substances and the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program. The board consists of the following nine members: the Attorney General, the secretary of the Department of Health Services, and the secretary of the Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection, or their designees; the chairperson of the Pharmacy Examining Board, the chairperson of the Medical Examining Board, the chairperson of the Dentistry Examining Board, and the chairperson of the Board of Nursing, or their designees; one psychiatrist; and one pharmacologist.

2025 Wisconsin Act 73 adds to the board's membership the chairperson of the Physician Assistant Affiliated Credentialing Board, or a designee.
