2025 Assembly Bill 23

Assembly Amendment 1

2025 ASSEMBLY BILL 23

2025 Assembly Bill 23 creates a Palliative Care Council in the Department of Health Services. Among other provisions, the bill contains certain council membership requirements. Specifically, the council consists of not more than 22 members, including five physicians. The five physician members include three palliative care physicians and two primary care physicians.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 changes the physician membership on the Palliative Care Council. Under the amendment, the five physician members must include two palliative care physicians, one pediatric palliative care physician, and two primary care physicians.

BILL HISTORY

Representative Snyder offered Assembly Amendment 1 on February 18, 2025. On March 13, 2025, the Assembly Committee on Health, Aging and Long-Term Care recommended adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 14; Noes, 1; and voted to recommend passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 14; Noes, 1.
