## 2025 ASSEMBLY BILL 91

Under 2023 Wisconsin Act 12, the school board of a first class city school district (Milwaukee Public Schools, or MPS) that is located within a first class city (the City of Milwaukee) must ensure that at least 25 school resource officers are present at schools within the school district and have completed a specified training course. Act 12 requires MPS and the City of Milwaukee to agree to an apportionment of the costs of meeting these requirements, but does not specify how the costs are to be apportioned.

Among other provisions, 2023 Assembly Bill 91 apportions 75 percent of the costs of meeting these requirements to MPS, and 25 percent to the City of Milwaukee.

## **ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1**

Assembly Amendment 1 modifies the apportionment in the bill, and instead establishes that MPS and the City of Milwaukee are each responsible for 50 percent of the costs.

## **BILL HISTORY**

Representative Donovan offered Assembly Amendment 1 on March 6, 2025. On March 11, 2025, the Assembly Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety recommended adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 13; Noes, 2; and voted to recommend passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 10; Noes, 5.
