



## 2025 ASSEMBLY BILL 3

February 3, 2025 - Introduced by Representatives MELOTIK, BEHNKE, BRILL, DITTRICH, DONOVAN, GOODWIN, GUNDRUM, KNODL, KREIBICH, MURPHY, MURSAU, TUSLER, VOS, WICHGERS and PIWOWARCZYK, cosponsored by Senators NASS, CABRAL-GUEVARA and WANGGAARD. Referred to Committee on Education.

1     **AN ACT to create** 115.28 (55p), 118.40 (2r) (b) 2. m., 118.40 (2x) (b) 2. m., 118.60  
2           (2) (a) 10., 119.23 (2) (a) 10. and 121.02 (1) (k) 4. of the statutes; **relating to:**  
3           incorporating cursive writing into the state model English language arts  
4           standards and requiring cursive writing in elementary grades.

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### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill requires the state superintendent of public instruction to incorporate cursive writing into the model academic standards for English language arts. The bill also requires all school boards, independent charter schools, and private schools participating in a parental choice program to include cursive writing in its respective curriculum for the elementary grades. Specifically, each elementary school curriculum must include the objective that pupils be able to write legibly in cursive by the end of fifth grade.

5           **SECTION 1.** 115.28 (55p) of the statutes is created to read:

3           **SECTION 2.** 118.40 (2r) (b) 2. m. of the statutes is created to read:

4           118.40 **(2r)** (b) 2. m. If the contract is for the operation of a charter school that  
5 includes the elementary grades, a requirement that the charter school's curriculum  
6 include the academic objective in s. 121.02 (1) (k) 4.

7           **SECTION 3.** 118.40 (2x) (b) 2. m. of the statutes is created to read:

8           118.40 **(2x)** (b) 2. m. If the contract is for the operation of a charter school that  
9 includes the elementary grades, a requirement that the charter school's curriculum  
10 include the academic objective in s. 121.02 (1) (k) 4.

11          **SECTION 4.** 118.60 (2) (a) 10. of the statutes is created to read:

12          118.60 **(2)** (a) 10. If the private school operates elementary grades, the private  
13 school includes in its curriculum the academic objective in s. 121.02 (1) (k) 4.

14          **SECTION 5.** 119.23 (2) (a) 10. of the statutes is created to read:

15          119.23 **(2)** (a) 10. If the private school operates elementary grades, the private  
16 school includes in its curriculum the academic objective in s. 121.02 (1) (k) 4.

17          **SECTION 6.** 121.02 (1) (k) 4. of the statutes is created to read:

18          121.02 **(1)** (k) 4. By July 1, 2026, include in a language arts curriculum plan  
19 under this paragraph the academic objective that pupils be able to write legibly in  
20 cursive by the end of grade 5. This subdivision does not apply to union high school  
21 districts.

22          **SECTION 7. Initial applicability.**

23          (1) INDEPENDENT CHARTER SCHOOL CONTRACTS. The treatment of s. 118.40

1 (2r) (b) 2. m. and (2x) (b) 2. m. first applies to a contract that is entered into,  
2 renewed, or modified on the effective date of this subsection.

3 (2) PRIVATE SCHOOLS PARTICIPATING IN A PARENTAL CHOICE PROGRAM. The  
4 treatment of ss. 118.60 (2) (a) 10. and 119.23 (2) (a) 10. first applies to an  
5 application to attend a private school under a parental choice program in the 2026-  
6 27 school year.
