

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin is in need of a comprehensive medical education planning framework:

To assist the Governor and Legislature to evaluate specific proposals for expansion in medical education resources, or for changes in direction of the State's role in medical education; and

To assist State and private agencies to relate their plans for medical education to overall State requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WARREN P. KNOWLES, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby establish a Task Force on Medical Education, as a Staff Committee whose membership shall include Donald C. Slichter, Chairman; William Kraus, Vice-Chairman; Bertram N. McNamara; Thomas H. Barland; William C. Kidd; Richard E. Vogt; Dr. Russell F. Lewis; Wallace L. Lemon; John W. Comee; Dr. Peter L. Eichman; Dr. Gerald A. Kerrigan; Senator Walter G. Hollander; Senator William C. Hansen; Assemblyman Norman Anderson; Assemblyman David G. Martin; T. A. Duckworth; O. H. Guenther; Donald F. Taylor; Mrs. Richard Cutler; and Dr. Norman O. Becker, for the purpose of developing a comprehensive medical education planning framework and to determine just what the role of the State of Wisconsin should be in medical education. Recommendations by the Task Force to be submitted to the Governor in report form on or before October 15, 1967.
