

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 17

# 17 WHEREAS, Wisconsin State Government, having been streamlined through the State Government Reorganization Act of 1967; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature, in Chapter 408, Laws of 1969, provided that under the general powers of the Executive Office, the Governor may create and abolish non-statutory committees; and

WHEREAS, numerous non-statutory committees have fulfilled the function for which they were created but have not previously been abolished,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, WARREN P. KNOWLES, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby declare that all non-statutory committees are abolished, excepting the following:

The coordinator shall keep a record of all appointments to, or resignations or removals from, such committees and shall provide for the retention and preservation of the records and reports of such committees and fulfill such other responsibilities as provided in the Statutes.
