EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 24

WHEREAS, the United States is facing an ever-increasing demand upon the supply of its natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the present methods of solid waste disposal, incineration and landfill, deplete our supply of natural resources and degrade the quality of our air, land, and water; and

WHEREAS, recycling is the best long-range solution to Wisconsin solid waste and other environmental problems; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin provides an ideal market for recycling with its variety of industry and large supply of waste materials; and

WHEREAS, industry, government, and the scientific community must make a unified effort to develop recycling in Wisconsin;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK J. LUCEY, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby create the

RECYCLING TASK FORCE

and charge the Task Force to develop a plan for a center to recover, reclaim and recycle all types of solid wastes.
